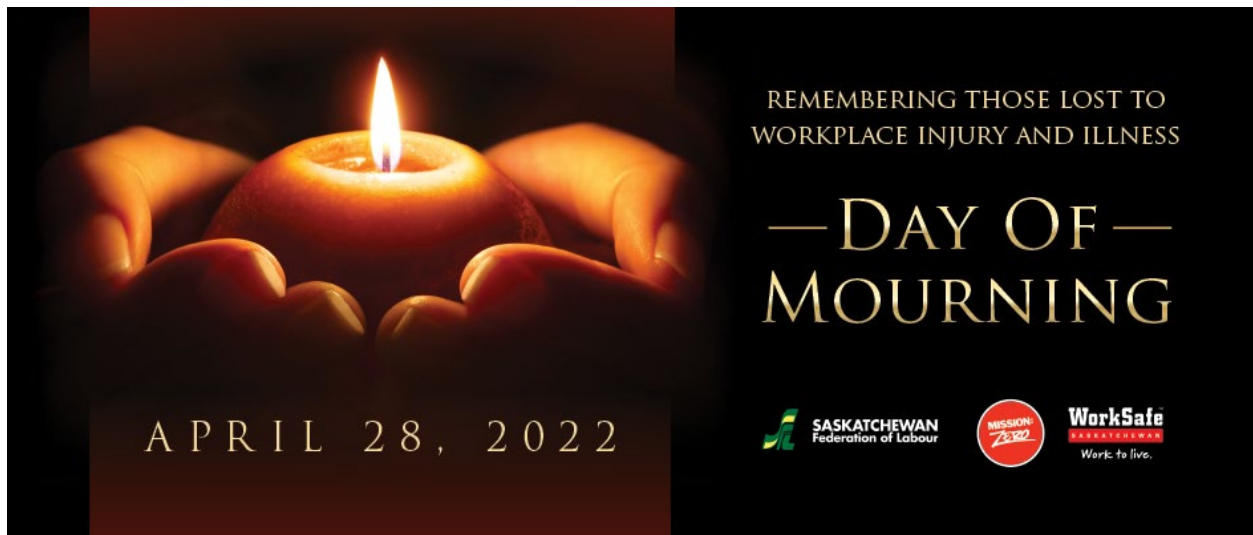

National Day of Mourning

Each year, Canada recognizes the National Day of Mourning on April 28 as a day for employers and employees to remember those who have died, as well as those who are injured or stricken by illness on the job.

On this day, Saskatchewan renews its commitment to improve occupational health and safety in the workplace. The Saskatchewan legislature will read the names of those who lost their lives to their work into the Provincial Record. The Canadian Labour Congress inscribes the names in the National Registry in Ottawa.

I encourage you to take an active role in promoting health and safety as a vibrant part of workplace culture. Take time to recognize those affected by work-related illnesses, injuries and deaths. Together we should always be looking for ways to improve health and safety in the workplace to ensure we all go home safe to our loved ones each and every day. Another way to show your support is by observing moments of silence and wearing ribbons or armbands.

In 2021, Saskatchewan recorded 31 workplace deaths. This is a sad statistic.
