

**OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR THE NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS
FOR THE OFFICERS' POSITIONS OF LOCAL UNION 2067
TO BE HELD ON JUNE 14, 2023**

In accordance with Local Union 2067 Bylaws and the Constitution of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, the Officers' Positions of Local 2067 are filled by election every four years. **2023 is an election year and this is your official election notice. The nominations for officers of Local Union 2067 will be held according to the attached schedule.**

Bylaw Article III, Section 4:

- (a) Nominations for Local Union Officers shall be held at the Regular Meeting of each Unit in April of election years.
- (b) Members of one Unit may nominate Members of another Unit for Local Union Office. It is not necessary that such nominees be confined to a particular Unit. A Member placing the name of another Member in nomination for office when the nominated Member is not present shall, at the time the nomination is made, give to the Unit Recorder evidence in writing signed by the nominee, that the nominee agrees to be a candidate for a specific Local Union Office. However, any Member being nominated in this manner cannot signify his/her intentions to be a candidate for more than one (1) specific Local Union Office.

Bylaw Article III, Section 5:

- (a) The officers shall be those provided for in Article XVI of the IBEW Constitution.
- (b) The Offices of Business Manager and Financial Secretary shall be combined.

Bylaw Article III, Section 6:

- (a) The Executive Board shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Treasurer and three (3) elective Members. There shall not be more than one (1) elective member elected from any one (1) employer, however, should there not be representative candidates from three (3) different employees, the next candidate(s) with the most numbers of votes shall be appointed.
- (b) The Joint Board shall consist of Local Union Officers and the Chairman of each Unit.

Bylaw Article III, Section 7:

- (b) No member shall be a candidate for more than one (1) office, except as provided in these bylaws and with approval of the International President. If nominated for more than one office, the member shall immediately declare for which office he/she will be a candidate. However, this shall not apply to offices which have been combined with the approval of the International President.
- (d) No member shall be eligible for office unless he/she has been a member of Local Union 2067 in continuous good standing for at least two (2) year immediately prior to nomination.

The election will be conducted by mail-in secret ballot, as per the election procedures contained within the bylaws, and will take place during the months of May and June 2023. The ballot count will be held on June 14, 2023, beginning at 10:00 a.m. All Members in good standing shall be mailed a

ballot not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to the above specified date. **To be eligible to be counted, ballots must be received at the designated Postal Station no later than the end of the business day on June 13, 2023**

Bylaw Article XII, Section 2:

- (a) Unit Officers shall be nominated at the regular meeting of each Unit in April and elected in June of the year the Local Union elects officers, in conjunction with Local Union Officer elections as per these Bylaws, Article III, Section 4(a) and Section 7(a). Only members of each such unit in good standing are eligible to nominate and vote for the Unit's officers.

Bylaw Article XII, Section 3:

- (a) No Member shall be a candidate for more than one (1) Unit Office. If nominated for more than one (1) office, the Member shall immediately declare for which office he/she will be a candidate. No Member shall be nominated for Unit Office unless they are present or signify their willingness in writing to be a candidate.

Bylaw Article XII, Section 4:

- (a) A member must have at least six (6) months' continuous standing in their Unit immediately prior to nomination to be eligible for office in their Unit, provided the Unit has been in existence for six (6) months or more.

All Officers shall be installed and begin their four-year term at the regular meeting of Local Union 2067 July 2023.
