Fellow Canadians,

The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 2067, representing over 2,200 workers across Saskatchewan, in virtually every building trade, from Power linemen to Millwrights to Heavy Equipment Operators to Electricians and many more, are proud to endorse Conservative Party of Canada Leader, Pierre Poilievre, for Prime Minister.

Pierre has earned our respect. It is time to put Canadian workers first for a change.

The Liberal Government has for years threatened the livelihoods of our members with irrational environmental regulations and industrial/consumer carbon taxation.

Liberal Government orders to close conventional coal power generation without a practical transition timeline have resulted in the continued threat of job loss for over 1,000 IBEW members in power generation and the coal miners we represent, creating devastation for not only their families, but their communities. If this wasn't enough, American coal-power would be required to heat Saskatchewan homes for years until provincial nuclear power generation could be established. Despite all efforts, the Liberal Government has maintained a blind ideology that refuses to respect our workers and refuses to respect our communities. Worse still, the Carney Liberal Party plans to increase industrial carbon taxation on Saskatchewan's vital job creating industries. Our workers cannot and will not stand for another Liberal Government refusing to listen to Saskatchewan workers.

In stark contrast, Pierre Poilievre and his Conservative Members of Parliament are the only federal politicians that have listened to our concerns, have learned about our industries and have advocated on our behalf. Conservatives are the only party talking about the brutal Chinese canola tariffs that are hurting the members we represent. IBEW Local 2067 has also established a very strong partnership with Premier Scott Moe and the Saskatchewan Party Government.

Through these partnerships, IBEW Local 2067 wholeheartedly believes that Pierre Poilievre is the strongest leader for Canadian workers.

Pierre Poilievre's Boots Not Suits election platform commits to reverse Liberal underfunding with a tenfold increase in the federal Union Innovation Training Program (UTIP), from \$25M annually to \$250M, with the intention to train 350,000 tradesmen. Pierre will not waste taxpayers' money on foolish Liberal programs, but he will spend taxpayers money where it matters most, on Canadian workers.

Pierre Poilievre's election platform is the only believable platform that will create powerful pay cheques for Canadian workers. After ten years of very serious economic decline, there is zero believability in the dramatic flip flops of Liberal Policy.
