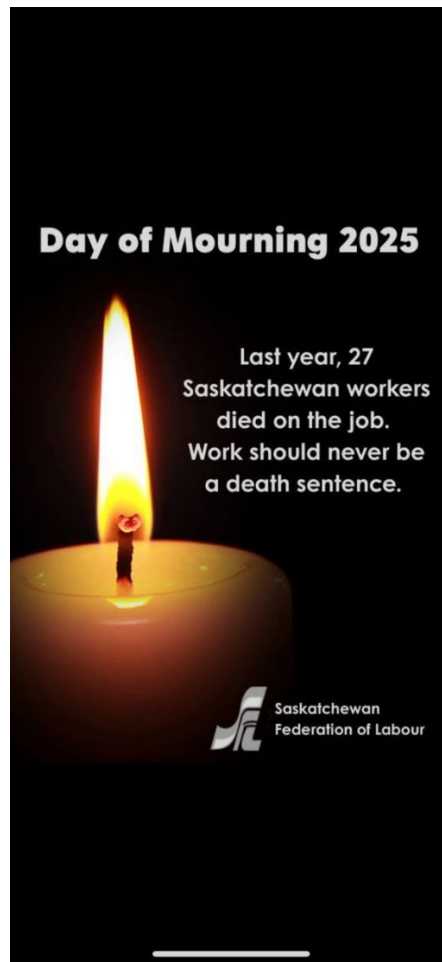

National Day of Mourning

In 2024, 27 workplace fatality claims were accepted by the Saskatchewan Workers' Compensation Board. This is a tragic statistic.
